To who it may concern:

I represent a group of amateur psychics who in doing various experiments have used your unsolved (professors) murder case as an experiment in psychometry.

Each of us worked independently and held the newspaper article, concentrating on who did it. I'm sorry that I can't tell you that I know we have come up with something that will help you, or that we know that we are accurate, because this is the 1st time we have tried this. However, the people in our group are definitely psychic. And I feel certain that our clues are pertinent to the murder.

The murderer: simple drawing by one student is enclosed. He was described as being a young man (probably a student), with a haircut similar to a long crew (flat on top), thin nose, thin mouth, oval or long eyes with very long eyelashes.
